Modern Hebrew is the core of the Judaic Studies major, but students of any major can enroll in Hebrew classes to fulfill the UA's second language requirement.



We offer **elementary**, **intermediate**, and **advanced levels** of Modern Hebrew.

Elementary Modern Hebrew (5 units each)

JUS 103A (5 units) and JUS 103B (5 units) are offered in fall and spring semesters respectively.

JUS 103A: Intensive introduction to basic oral skills, reading and writing to accomplish simple conversation and read easy Hebrew with comprehension.

JUS 103B: Intensive introduction to establish foundation for beginning fluency in conversation, reading and writing.

Intermediate Modern Hebrew (5 units each)

JUS 203A (5 units) and JUS 203B (5 units) are offered in fall and spring semesters respectively.

JUS 203A and JUS 203B: Instruction to achieve moderate fluency in conversation, reading and writing.

Advanced Modern Hebrew (3 units each)

Successful completion of JUS303A (a grade of 'C' or above), is a prerequisite for enrollment in JUS 303B.

JUS 303A and 303B: Advanced instruction in modern Hebrew language and literature.
